As part of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) ongoing WaterSense "We're for Water" campaign, this year's Fix a Leak Week encourages Americans to help put a stop to the more than 1 trillion gallons of water wasted from household leaks each year.

Sponsored by EPA's WaterSense program, Fix a Leak Week is March 19-25, 2018. In support of "We're for Water", Murray City Water is promoting finding and fixing water leaks.

Leaks can account for more than 10,000 gallons of water in an average home, every year the same amount of water it takes to wash 270 loads of laundry. As a WaterSense partner, we are encouraging consumers to find and fix leaks to save water in our community.

As part of Fix a Leak Week Murray City Water Department will be engaging our community in a number of different ways, here are just a few examples.
