Minutes for April 25, 2018

1. Minutes for March 28, 2018 were not approved due to no quorum and will be voted on via email.
2. Jennifer reported on the StEP program: We were accepted and working on the Letter of Intent. The cost will be a total of \$900 for the 2-year program. Board members are invited to attend any of the modules that may be of interest to them. The intent is to help establish best practices for museum and artifact collection for the museum.
3. Jennifer reported on Museum duties: She has compiled a list of completed oral histories. Mildred recommended that oral histories of past mayors should be obtained.

Jennifer has also scheduled the Cemetery Tours for May 22-24. 5 schools with 3-4 classes each are scheduled so far. Jennifer will confirm with the following volunteers: Rebecca Santa Cruz, Laurel Shepard, and Steve Cotton.

4. Katie gave a Murray Theater Update: Parks & Rec Director, Kim Sorenson gave a presentation to Mayor and City Council Tuesday, April 17 at work meeting. They seemed excited and supportive of the restoration project. Lori and Director Sorenson completed and submitted the Cultural Facilities Grant application that is administered by Salt Lake County.
5. Katie gave the Heritage Award update. Mary Ann Kirk received the Heritage Award during Tuesday, April 17 City Council meeting.
6. National Archives review: April 26th, Lori and Katie will be attending the process for the Hobbs nomination to the National Historic Register. They will report back on the decision.

8. Katie gave a Museum Musing update. Katie will create webpage on the Cultural Arts and History site for Museum Musings with the two subheadings: Museum Mysteries and Museum Memes. Content for Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter are ready to be programmed and will be managed by Jennifer and Katie. Museum Mysteries will begin the 2nd Monday of May and continue till the end of September. Museum Memes will begin with the Murray Journal May edition – the memes will be printed in the Murray Journal. Both activities intent is to drive people to visit the museum.
