Minutes for March 27, 2019

- I. Minutes for February 27, 2019 were approved as written.
- II. Staff reports – Lori asked the board if they were interested in volunteering for either the museum or the cemetery tours in May. Jennifer Broschinsky from the museum was absent at the meeting and Lori was unable to give the times and dates that the volunteers would be needed. She will get that information from Jennifer and email it out to the board.
- III. Lori gave the board the updated information on the “walk around tour” on March 8th and the following RDA meeting held on March 19th.
 - a. The “walk around tour” was implemented by Economic Development and Community Director, Melinda Greenwood at the request of resident Janis Strobel. The tour was for “Block 1” which is the west side of State Street from Wrights costume shop to 4800 south and back to Poplar Street and 5th Ave. Attending were staff from Economic and Community Development, Parks and Recreation (Cultural Arts) UDOT, Preservation Utah, Gloria Hayley Design, Dale Cox, Councilman Jim Brass, Janis Strobel and Brent Barnette. Historical information was share by Councilman Brass, and Melinda showed overhead images of the block.
 - b. The RDA meeting continued discussion about “Block 1” and the MCCR ordinance. City Council asked Melinda and her department to bring back some options for their consideration of how the ordinance could be rewritten to make development of the property less restrictive to developers. Lori thought that Melinda’s department will want feedback from the history board and said she would keep the board updated on the progresses made.
- IV. Demolitions
 - a. The home on 6256 S. 900 E. has been sold and a developer will be tearing down the house and rebuilding a care center for adults with emotional problems. The house was on the historic registry. Lori had obtained pictures and the board did not think any other documentation was needed.
- V. Misc.
 - a. Laurel asked Lori about the pillars that are missing on the Warenski-Duvall building. She will check on them.
 - b. Lori announced that the City was awarded \$10,000 CLG grant which is a matching grant and will be used for a feasibility study for the Murray Mansion.
- VI. Sara, Laurel and Pam will be unable to attend the meeting in April. Lori said she will check to see if the other board members will be present and if not, will cancel the April meeting.
