The Parks & Recreation Board Meeting was called to order at 5:35pm.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

A motion was made to approve the minutes. Motion was seconded. Motion was unanimous.

**CITIZEN COMMENTS**

There were no citizen comments.

**MURRAY THEATER UPDATE**

The city has hired Hogan Construction as the Construction Manager/General Contractor (CMGC) for the Murray Theater renovation. CRSA Architecture continues to work on the new schematic for the theater. Kim was able to relay to the board members the plans were progressing nicely and goals for the renovation execution were coming along in a timely fashion.

**PAVILION UPDATE**

Kim informed board of the pavilion replacement progress. The contractor chosen for the project was Kevin D. Allen. Kim stated pavilions 1-4 have currently been demolished, aside from a few pillars at pavilion 4. Pavilions were ordered as of December 11, 2019 from Polygon company. Construction along with delivery of the pavilions from Polygon should be expected the beginning of March 2020. The project is on schedule and on budget. The timeline to complete replacement of pavilions 1-4 is scheduled for May 1, 2020.

### **WINCHESTER PARK PAVILION**

Kim spoke with board concerning the plan to offer a boulder playground at Winchester Pavilion located along the Jordan River Parkway. The board discussed composing a letter that could be submitted to the city council in support of this customized playground. The members were in favor of constructing this type of playground and expressed enthusiasm in awaiting the outcome.

### **DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Kim spoke with the board concerning a proposal from Aquatics Manager, Amanda Sangroniz. Amanda oversees the indoor and outdoor pool areas and proposed approval could be extended to change the outdoor pool hours to accommodate additional special groups during the slower hours of the evening. Her proposal would only affect the Monday through Thursday schedule as her desire is to change the closing time of regular pool hours from 8 pm to 7 pm. This would offer an earlier start time for outside reservations to utilize the pool. Currently pool use during the week tapers at 6 pm. The board expressed they would like to speak to Amanda about the change before approving. It was suggested she attend the next Park Board meeting for input.

Kim also informed the board of the new equipment the Park Center was installing. Thorough research efforts have been put forth to secure the best equipment for the center. The current equipment is extremely old yet served the center well.

Kim notified the board pavilion 5 replacement is scheduled for Fall of 2020. The design process is underway for this pavilion and it will be the last to be replaced out of the Murray Park pavilion project.
