Murray History Advisory Board Chair Statement

In accordance with the Governor and Utah Department of Health's *Phased Guidelines for the General Public "Utah Leads Together"*, and the Utah Legislature's House Joint Resolution 504, adopted on June 17, 2020, extending the *State of Emergency Due to the Infectious Disease COVID-19 Novel Coronavirus*, I have determined that to protect the health and welfare of Murray citizens, an in person meeting of the Murray History Advisory ("Advisory Board"), including attendance by the public and the Advisory Board is not practical or prudent.

The Center for Disease Control states that COVID-19 is easily spread from person to person between people who are in close contact with one another. The spread is through respiratory droplets when an infected person coughs, sneezes or talks and may be spread by people who are non-symptomatic.

Considering the continued rise of COVID-19 case counts in Utah, meeting in an anchor location presents substantial risk to the health and safety of those in attendance because physical distancing measures may be difficult to maintain in the Parks and Recreation Department Offices.

It is my intent to safeguard the lives of Murray residents, business owners, employees and officials by meeting remotely through electronic means.
