Murray City History Advisory Board Chair Statement

Open and Public Meeting Act – Electronic Meeting
Utah State Code 52-4-207(5)

This statement is in regard to the Murray City Arts Advisory Board meeting scheduled for February 2, 2022. In accordance with Utah Code section 52-4-207(5), and due to infectious disease COVID-19 Novel Coronavirus ("Public Health Emergency"), having weighed the responsibilities of a governmental body to hold in-person public meetings against the safety of its members and the public given the current status of the Public Health Emergency, the chair has determined that holding an in-person meeting presents a substantial risk to the health or safety of those who would otherwise be present.

The chair has determined that meeting in an anchor location presents substantial risk to the health and safety of those who may be present at the anchor location because physical distancing measures may be difficult to maintain. Federal, state and local leaders have all acknowledged the global pandemic. It is my intent to safeguard the lives of Murray residents, business owners, employees and elected officials by meeting remotely through electronic means without an anchor location.
