EFFECTIVE FRIDAY, MARCH 13, 2020, MURRAY CITY MAYOR BLAIR CAMP TO DECLARE LOCAL EMERGENCY. THE CITY WILL CLOSE THE SENIOR CENTER, RECREATION CENTER, LIBRARY AND MUSEUM. THE CITY IS POSTPONING ALL RECREATION PROGRAMS, BOTH INDOOR AND OUTDOOR, AND ALL CULTURAL ARTS PROGRAMS UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE DUE TO CORONAVIRUS CONCERNS

MURRAY CITY – Effective Friday, March 13, 2020, Murray City Mayor Blair Camp will declare a local emergency amid concerns about the widespread coronavirus outbreak. The Murray City senior center, recreation center, library and museum will be closed as of Friday, March 13, 2020 until further notice.

The city is also suspending all recreation and cultural arts programs. Events such as Fix-a-Leak Week, and our recycling drop off for antifreeze, batteries, oil and paint (ABOP) are also suspended.

The city is taking these precautionary measures to prevent potential spread of the disease. A full listing of facilities closed will be available on Friday, March 13, 2020 on the city website, murray.utah.gov.

The city will continue to operate during this time. City facilities not specifically listed as closed will remain open during usual business hours. Public meetings will proceed as scheduled, although the public may choose to watch the meetings via livestream on the city's Facebook page, Murray City, Utah.
