



Public Works Projects

Asphalt Overlay

- 1 Penguin Circle
- 2 Lucky Clover Lane - between Germania Ave. and Spring Clover Dr.
- 3 Clover Circle
- 4 Blossom Circle
- 5 Lucky Clover Circle

Road Rebuild

- 6 Hanauer Street Extension - roadway has been excavated to sub grade. Utility installation has begun (sewer, water, and stormwater).

Non-paving Maintenance

- 7 Sidewalk repairs and trip hazard removal (Sanford Drive & Lasalle neighborhood)
- 8 Sidewalk repairs and trip hazard removal (Greenfield Ave.)
- 9 Traffic signal upgrade (5300 South College Dr.)

Water

- 10 State St water line, 4500 S to 5300 S - Murray Park entrance on State will be closed during work (2 week duration).
- 11 4500 South Well -construction complete, temp permit issued by the State.
- 12 Murray Park Well - construction complete. Temp permit has been issued by the State.
- 13 6230 South 320 - 440 East - replacing water line. Should be complete by late September.
- 14 Well Maintenance - 900 E. Winchester Street. Close to power, expected to take a few months to complete.

Roadway Projects

Asphalt Overlays:

Street Crews will be working to grind and overlay the following roads in the next few weeks:

- Penguin Cir.
- Lucky Clover Lane – between Germania Ave. and Spring Clover Dr.
- Clover Cir.
- Blossom Cir.
- Lucky Clover Cir.

Road Rebuilds:

Hanauer Street extension work in the downtown area is proceeding. The roadway has been excavated to the sub grade. The sewer and water line installation has begun, and the stormwater lines will soon be under construction as well. This work will take several months to complete.

Non-Paving Maintenance Projects

In the next month crews will be doing sidewalk repairs and trip hazard removal in the Sanford Drive and La Salle neighborhood, south of 5900 South and Greenfield Ave.

Traffic Signal Upgrades

The traffic signal upgrade design has begun at the intersection of 5300 South and College Dr.

Water Projects

- State Street water line replacement project - the entrance to Murray Park on State Street will be closed while this work is done. This should take about two weeks to complete.
- The 4500 South well is complete, and the Utah Division of Drinking Water has issued a temporary operating permit. The well is currently being used to help provide water for our system needs.
- The Murray Park well construction is complete. The Utah Division of Drinking Water has issued a temporary operating permit. The well is currently being used to help provide water for our system needs.
- Water crews are replacing a water line on 6230 South between 320 and 440 East; this work should be completed in late September.
- Maintenance work has begun on a well located at 900 East and Winchester Street, and will take a few months to complete.

SEPTEMBER 2020

Wastewater Projects

- Wastewater crews are working diligently to clean and inspect the existing sewer lines throughout the City.
- The Central Valley Wastewater Reclamation Facility continues to make progress with the major treatment plant enhancements required to meet water quality standards and provide safer work environments for the plant personnel. This work includes a new Biological Nutrient Removal process, Side Stream Nitrogen Removal, Secondary Clarifiers, New Cogeneration Components, Water Reuse Facilities, Plant Headworks Screening Rehabilitation and Odor Control systems among other needed maintenance projects.
