

Diversity and Inclusion Ad Hoc Advisory Task Force

The Diversity and Inclusion Ad Hoc Task Force was established to research and examine the relationship between the community at large and marginalized and underrepresented communities within the context of City policies, practices, and programming and to provide feedback that will help foster mutual understanding and respect among all members of the City. This Ad Hoc Task Force will work to encourage inclusion and to discourage prejudice and discrimination against marginalized communities including any person, group, or any other status protected by law on account of age, race, creed, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, sex, or disability.

This Ad Hoc Task Force shall assist the City:

1. In improving the quantity and quality of inclusive experiences and opportunities for residents, employee, and visitors;
2. providing a strong sense of community, actively engage residents, support events and traditions that build bridges within the communities and
3. ensuring services are equally accessible to all residents by identifying barriers and making recommendations to the City.

This Ad Hoc Task Force shall be composed of nine (9) members who will be appointed by the City Council. Five (5) members shall be residents of the City. The remaining four (4) members shall be at large members and may either be City residents, owners of businesses within the City or individuals providing services to under-represented communities within the City. Meetings will be held on the second Thursday of each month from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Meetings will be conducted electronically, through Zoom, until it is safe to hold in person meetings.

This Ad Hoc Task Force shall automatically terminate and disband upon the final submission of its recommendations to the City.

Application Procedure

- Applications should be completed and returned to the City Council office by 5:00 p.m. on March 5, 2021.
- Additional information, such as a resume, may be included, but is not necessary.
- Interviews will be conducted with the top candidates
- The City Council will appoint the members of this Ad Hoc Task Force.
- It is anticipated the first meeting for this Task Force will be held in May 2021.
