

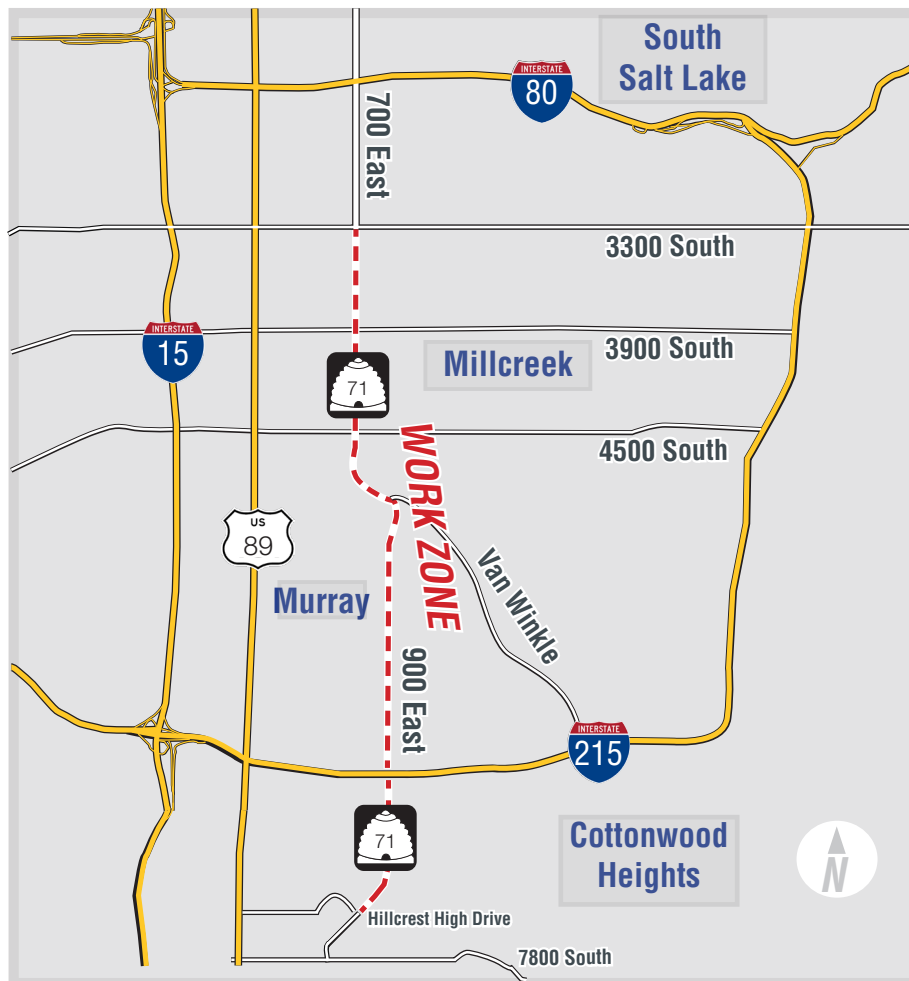

Hillcrest High Drive to 3300 South

UDOT to Rehabilitate SR-71 from Hillcrest High Drive to 3300 South

Beginning as early as June 1, 2021, and continuing through late August, the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will renew approximately six miles of SR-71 (700/900 East) from Hillcrest High Drive to 3300 South (*see map below*). The project includes placing a new roadway surface, called a microsurface, and replacing sidewalk pedestrian ramps along the corridor to bring them up to current standards. Pedestrian access will be maintained, but routes may vary throughout the duration of the work. During the microsurfacing portion of the project, starting in mid-July, motorists should anticipate intermittent lane/intersection closures and moderate traffic delays nightly, between 7 p.m. and 9 a.m., with the exception of Saturday nights. When completed, the life of the pavement will be extended by several years, and pedestrian access will be improved.



For your safety, as well as the safety of those working in the area, please use extra caution and stay alert while driving through construction zones.
