

NOTICE OF PROPOSED TAX INCREASE

MURRAY CITY

MURRAY CITY is proposing to increase its property tax revenue.

- The MURRAY CITY tax on a \$523,000 residence would increase from \$477.21 to \$533.59, which is \$56.38 per year.
- The MURRAY CITY tax on a \$523,000 business would increase from \$867.66 to \$970.17, which is \$102.51 per year.
- If the proposed budget is approved, MURRAY CITY would increase its property tax budgeted revenue by 11.77% above last year's property tax budgeted revenue excluding eligible new growth.

All concerned citizens are invited to a public hearing on the tax increase.
